



# Mystery Project Supply List

This is a mystery project to celebrate America's Semiquicentennial. Following is the supply list for the entire project. A part of the project will be delivered each month, with the last part of the project delivered in June 2026.

This project will include 4 large embroidery designs. Use the same backing fabric for all 4 designs. I chose an off-white fabric with tan swirls for mine. The background fabric amount in the supply list should be enough for all 4.

There will be red and blue borders, and free-standing embroidery stars that could be in the same fabric or a different red, blue, or white fabric. Think America when you are gathering up your supplies!

And of course, there will be a way to quilt your finished project.

## Shopping List

- 1 yard of background fabric (for 4 hoopings -- I used an off-white with tan swirls)
- 1-3/4 yard backing fabric, cut to - 28" x 62"
- 6" x 8" scrap of white fabric
- 6" x 6" gold/bronze scrap of fabric
- 4" x 6" scrap of white fabric
- 3/4 yard Red patriotic fabric
- 3/4 yard Blue Patriotic fabric
- 1/3 yard binding fabric
- 28" x 62" mid- or low-loft batting (crib size)
- Fourteen 6" square scraps of batting for stars
- 2 yards Shape Flex 101
- Medium Weight Tear-Away Stabilizer
- Sew & Wash Away Stabilizer
- Chenille needle (or a large-eye, sharp needle)
- 10.5" square ruler
- Print & Stick Target Paper (helpful)

### Notes about background fabric:

- To reduce puckering, we recommend hooping the background fabric. (Do not hoop stabilizer & baste.)
- The largest design is 7.0" x 7.1"
- A yard of fabric should be plenty of background fabric for all 4 designs. If you are using a 10" x 16" hoop, you may need more background fabric.
